- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit Newsquest (Yorkshire and North East) Ltd will notify you 7 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request Newsquest (Yorkshire and North East) Ltd to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit by Newsquest (Yorkshire and North East) Ltd. or your Bank or Building Society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your Bank or Building Society.
- If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when Newsquest (Yorkshire and North East) Ltd asks you to.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your Bank or Building Society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.
